ORDER

THIS MATTER IS BEFORE THE COURT on the “United States’ Notice Of Election To Intervene In Part And Consent Request To Unseal Redacted Complaint” (Document No. 51) filed August 18, 2026. This matter has been referred to the undersigned Magistrate Judge pursuant to 28 U.S.C. § 636(b), and immediate review is appropriate.

The United States has intervened in part of this action pursuant to the False Claims Act, 31 U.S.C. § 3730(b)(2) and (4), and requests that the Court to unseal a redacted version of the Relator’s Complaint (Document No. 51-2). Having carefully considered the motion and the record, and noting consent of the Relator and Defendant, the undersigned will grant the request to unseal the redacted Complaint.

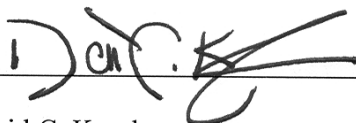
IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that:
